- Students must have raised either a pig, lamb, or goat prior to raising a steer project.
- Steer projects can only be purchased from approved breeders that have been discussed with the advisors PRIOR to purchase.
- **Steer projects cannot be brought onto the farm before October 15, 2014.** A move in day/time will need to be arranged with the instructor.
- If a steer will be purchased through the school, students must bring a \$200 deposit and have **NO outstanding debt to FJUHS**D from prior projects.

- The steer projects arrive in approx. Oct/November and are raised until July.
- FUHS FFA participates in THREE approved cattle shows, La Habra Valley Fair, Orange HS livestock show, and OC Fair. ***If a student plans to attend any other show, it needs to be approved prior to the show and the students will need to agree to a 'quarantine' time when returning to the farm. This is for the health and safety of all of the project animals.***

PLEASE RETURN THIS APPLICATION WITH A SIGNED PROJECT CONTRACT TO MRS. ALCOTT BY SEPTEMBER 8, 2014. AFTER APPROVAL, STUDENTS WILL BE NOTIFIED AND A MINIMUM OF \$200 DEPOSIT WILL BE DUE BY OCTOBER 15, 2014.
